Michael Smith of The Met said he is trying to re-schedule the show for Nov. 16, although nothing is firm.

Refunds are available through G&B Select-a-Seat, although Jack Lucas of G&B advised ticketholders to "hold tight" until they see if the show will be re-scheduled.
